This all-round usable camera is light-weighted and takes small space in spite of its robust construction. Due to this, it is easy to transport. Another virtue of this camera is, that it can be unfolded to make the exposure very quickly. Besides the ability to focus with a rack, it is capable of the basic movements. It is an excellent camera for both traveling and studio photography.

After unfolding it, in the initial position the camera is ready to be used with 65-150 mm focal distance lenses, however by means of an extra extension, a maximum extension of 300 mm can be reached. This extra extension is activated by loosening two screws, then pushing it forward from the base of the camera.

After reaching the desired extension, it has to be fixed by the screws. Fine focusing is done by means of racks.



Movements of front:

- rise: 25 mm
- fall: 25 mm
- Tilting by the axis at the bottom is limited only by the bellows.
- swing: 15-15 °

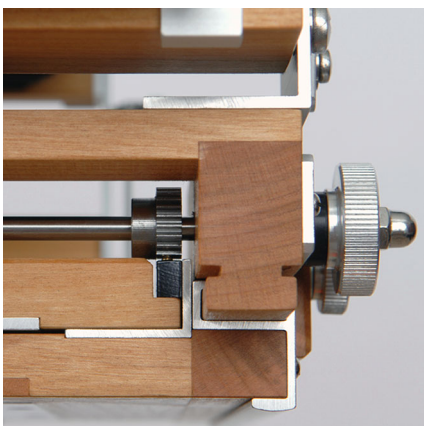
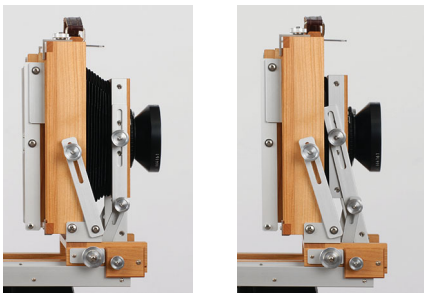
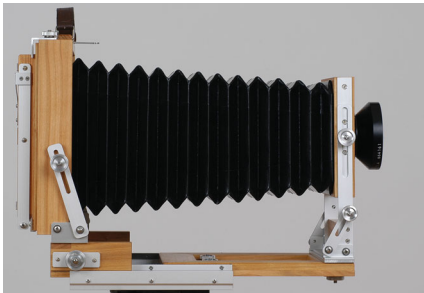


Rear

is tilted asymmetrically forwards and backwards along the axis at the bottom. The measure of tilting is limited only by the bellows, however backwards up to 25°.
